

Top 10 Resort Camp Questions

1. What meals are included at a UCA/UDA Resort Camp?

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner are provided at most of our Resort Camps. However, there are a few exceptions. Some Resort Camps offer Lunch and Dinner, Breakfast and Dinner, or No meals at all. A small refrigerator and microwave, or a full kitchen will be included in the rooms where all meals are not provided. There are also several restaurants located on site and in the surrounding areas of all UCA/UDA Resort Camp sites. 2. Are towels and linens provided by the resort?

Towels and linens will be provided by all UCA/UDA Resort camp sites, with the exception being The Hilton Head Resort where towels are not provided. Towels are changed once a day and each room will contain towels for each room occupant. For example, in a room housing four guests there will be 4 towels, 4 hand towels, and 4 washclothes. If a guest plans to use more than one towel or take multiple showers, extra towels are suggested. Beach towels are recommended since most resorts include a pool, water park, or beach access.

3. When do I need to pay for a UCA/UDA Resort Camp? What methods of payment are acceptable?

Each customer's balance should be paid in full 45 days prior to the first day of camp. WITH NO EXCEPTIONS! UCA/UDA accepts several types of payments: Personal Check (no gym checks please), Purchase Order (signed by principal for full amount of camp), Credit Card, or Money Order.

4. When does a team check in/check out of the resort?

Camp registration will start at 9am on the first day of camp. Guest will not check in to their rooms at this time, instead UCA/UDA will allow time at dinner to check into the Resort. Normal check-in time for resorts is not until 4pm, by waiting until dinner to check in UCA/UDA can guarantee rooms will be ready. Each squad will be given 1 room to house all luggage until check in.

5. Will teams be housed together at the resort?

UCA/UDA can not guarantee squads will be housed together. We reserve the same room type at each resort, and most resorts do not put similar room types next to one another. UCA/UDA will make sure squads are housed as close as possible to each other.

6. Are teams allowed to decorate the room, hallways, or windows of the resort?

Teams are not allowed to decorate their rooms, hallways, or windows at the resorts. UCA/UDA will not be the only guest residing at the resorts during camp; therefore we want our guests to be respectful to the other visitors of the resorts.

7. Are parents allowed to come to a Resort Camp?

Parents are welcome to watch any of the team performances throughout camp. These performances included the Home Pom routine the first night of camp and the Final Camp Evaluations the last day of camp. If a parent wishes to stay at the resort during camp, they should first check with their child's coach/sponsor for permission and prices.

8. Where do coaches/advisors or male participants stay?

UCA/UDA has no rules against coaches/advisors rooming with participants, unless it is a male coach/advisor and female participant or vice versa. We are aware some schools do not allow coaches/advisors and participants to room together, and we will try our best to accommodate these teams. UCA/UDA does not allow male and female participants rooming together. In either situation, UCA/UDA will ask the coaches/advisors to list themselves or male participants in their own room.

*Coaches/Advisors please make sure to request an additional room for yourselves or male participants when registering for a Resort Camp. If only 1 coach/advisor or male participant will occupy a room they will be responsible for the accompanying room rate. UCA/UDA will try to provide a smaller room type to help with cost, but we can not guarantee this assistance. UCA/UDA does not allow participants of different teams to room together.

9. Where are Cheer/Dance Classes held at a Resort Camp?

UCA/UDA will use the Ballrooms or Convention Centers that are located on most of the Resort Camp sites for cheer and dance classes. We will also utilize any outdoor facilities when available. Please check the Resort Camp website at www.uca.varsity.com/resorts.aspx for more information about alternative sites due to incimate weather.

10. Are teams allowed to come early or stay late at a Resort Camp?

Teams are allowed to come early or stay late at a Resort Camp. However, UCA/UDA can not guarantee the same room rate will apply to an extended stay. These prices vary from resort to resort.
